



Dear Parents,

Are you excited? It's time to start thinking about NYR!! Nationwide Youth Roundup will be held July 22nd -26th. We will leave for Colorado on Thursday, July 19th at 4:30 a.m. and will stay the night at the church on July 18th. Here is a breakdown of the cost:

Registration - \$80 (\$80 Due by May 13th)
Gas - \$75
Food - \$50 (during the week)
Activity - \$50
Total \$255 (will be lowered for students participating in fundraising)

The remaining balance after registration (\$175 before fundraising) needs to be paid by July 8th.

We will coordinate two fundraisers this year, students who participate in fundraising will have a lower price according to how much is raised. Easter breakfast will be our first fundraiser, and we will raffle off a handmade Afghan made by Sarah Bradshaw for the second. For Easter breakfast, the proceeds raised for NYR will be distributed evenly between all students serving during Easter Breakfast. For the raffle, the money each student raises will be applied directly to their total cost. The final prices will be available at the beginning of June. **The \$80/\$40 registration fee is still due by May 13th, along with the medical release/registration form.**

There will also be a price break for Families that attend. Families that attend NYR in 2018 will have a registration price of \$40 per person instead of \$80. This includes families that are Husband/Wife or Parents/ Student(s). This is specific to Rising Sun families, not for all NYR attendees.

Additional cost that individuals will be responsible for during the trip:

Additional Spending Money	- \$40 recommended (optional)
NYR offering	- \$20 (optional)
Group t-shirt	- \$10-\$12 (optional)

Registration Check List

Inside of this NYR Informational packet is one Registration form, and one medical release form. It's possible that you have already filled out the medical release form for 2018. If so, you do not need to fill out another one. One registration paper needs to be filled out per person. Here's a step by step guide to help the registration process.

1. Go to risingsunchurch.org
2. Scroll down until you see the NYR registration link. Click on it.
3. Follow the directions online until completed.
4. Finalize the registration by entering your payment information.
 - a. If any of the following doesn't work, call Dillon.
5. Fill out the attached NYR registration form. You may make copies or take more than one packet if needed.
6. Put your completed NYR Registration forms and Medical Release in the wire basket outside of Dillon's office before May 13th.
7. If you plan to pay the \$175 and do not plan to participate in fundraising, you may do so anytime, and skip #8.
8. Wait to hear the total amount after fundraising is finalized to pay the remaining balance after registration.
9. Pay the remaining balance by July 8th.

What is a military shower?

1. Enter shower.
2. Turn on water to get wet.
3. Turn off water.
4. Apply soap and lather.
5. Turn water back on to rinse.

7. Enjoy these three minutes of your day as you don't get to do them again until tomorrow.

What's the weather like?

The evenings/nights at NYR can get quite cool, sometimes dipping into the low-mid 40s. We are at an elevation of almost 8,000 feet above sea level. Many fare quite well with just sweatshirts and wind breakers, but be sure to pack according to your tolerance (or lack of) to the weather. Rain can be quite common, and we hold all sessions regardless of the weather conditions, so a rain coat or a poncho would be recommended. During the day, the temperature will get into the 80s or low 90s.

Conference guidelines.

The following list outlines the guidelines NYR has set to ensure a safe and memorable event. Some of them are in compliance with state laws, some invoke common sense, and some are for well-being of all who attend NYR. Your cooperation will provide for an enjoyable week.

1. Anyone under the age of 12 must be accompanied by a parent or legal guardian. This comes from the state of Colorado, and not NYR.
2. Nationwide Youth Roundup is a Christian gathering. Please come with a cooperative attitude and a desire to grow in the Lord.
3. Every person must register. Please do so on arrival. Each registrant must wear the official wristband ticket at all times. Anyone who is not wearing one will be escorted to the registration booth to register.
4. All youth, through senior high school, must be sponsored by an adult (youth leader, minister, parent, or guardian). Permission must be granted by the sponsor before leaving the grounds.
5. Sponsors are expected to see that their young people attend all services and classes.
6. No reserved seating by leaving blankets, chairs, etc. These items will be subject to removal. All seating will be first come, first serve for each service.
7. Shower houses will be closed for cleaning purposes each day during the evening services. Any articles found in the shower houses will be removed.
8. All outer clothing must be modest and free from suggestive or offensive imprints. Shorts may be worn at all times, subject to your sponsor's consent.
9. Offensive language, alcohol, tobacco, illegal substances, and firearms are strictly prohibited.
10. All fires must be extinguished when unattended, including lanterns and stoves.
11. The lodge is off limits to anyone who does not have a reservation there.
12. Unmarried members of the opposite sex are not to be in each others quarters under any circumstances.
13. Campers are required to be in their sleeping quarters and quiet by the announced curfew.
14. Live trees are not to be cut down. Please use only dead trees that have already been cut down for firewood. Wildflowers cannot be picked. They are protected by law in Colorado.

15. No pets are allowed on the NYR campgrounds. There are local kennels available for boarding your pet if you must bring it with you.

This authority is granted to any representative of the Rising Sun Church of Christ only after a reasonable effort has been made to contact us. This consent is valid while the child is in the care of Rising Sun Church of Christ and participating in activities sponsored by or endorsed by the Church. I and/or we do further hereby authorize release of the medical information contained herein to adult representatives of the Church in order to provide for the medical care of our child. I and/or we agree to pay all fees and costs arising from this action in obtaining medical treatment. I and/or we further release Rising Sun Church of Christ and its ministers, leaders, employees, volunteers, and agents from any claim that my child or that I and/or we may have against them as a result of injury or illness incurred during the course of participation in the activities of the church including (without limitation) any claims of negligence or breach of warranty. This release of liability is also intended to cover all claims that members of the child's or his/her family or estate, heirs, representatives, and assigns may have against Rising Sun Church of Christ or its ministers, leaders, employees, volunteers, or agents from any and all claims arising from my child's participation in its activities and programs, or as a result of injury or illness to my child during such activities.
